Are you currently a sophomore or junior? Do you live in the City of Madison? Do you want a paid summer internship?

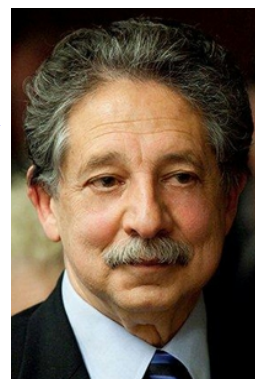
Apply to the Wanda Fullmore Youth Internship Program!
